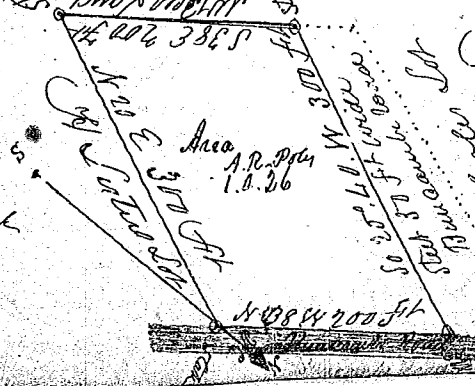


John South Carolina 3 Know all men by these presents, that I Wm. M<sup>o</sup> Bee  
 of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration  
 of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by Henry Cole of the Village of  
 Santee in the State aforesaid Have granted, bargained, sold and released  
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry  
 Cole All that lot of Land near the Village of Greenville on the Buncombe  
 road Beginning on a stake on or near the Buncombe road turns north  
 & west West 200 feet to a stake, thence South 21 degrees West 300 feet to  
 a Stake once about 50  
 feet wide, thence North 21 East 300 feet along a line of the said  
 land to the beginning, be the same more or less. Together with all  
 singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have  
 and to hold full and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the  
 said Henry Cole, his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind  
 myself, my heirs, executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend,  
 to hold and singular the said premises, unto the said Henry Cole, his heirs &  
 assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whom  
 lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof  
 and witness my hand and seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, and in the forty second  
 year of the Independence of the United States of America  
 Wm. M<sup>o</sup> Bee  
 sealed and delivered, in the presence of 3 Wm. M<sup>o</sup> Bee Esq  
 before J. H. Benedict George Boyle
