

The State of South Carolina. - Hence all men by these presents that we Anna Shumate and Lewis H. Shumate, Heirs of S. D. Shumate Dec. all of the State aforesaid; in consideration of one thousand dollars to us paid by Micajah Jordan of Greenville District and State aforesaid. Have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Micajah Jordan a certain plantation or tract of land containing two hundred and twenty five acres, more or less situate in the said and District aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain Creek beginning on land Chesnut St on the Creek, thence S 10 E 44.75 to a pine St thence S 80 E 10-50 to a line St on the creek, thence up the said Creek 13 to an Iron 10 rods 3x, thence N 77 E 40 to a rock 3x, thence S 10 W 8.50 to a hickory 3x thence N 6. 02 N 50 to a red oak 3x thence S 44 E 4 50 to a red oak 3x thence S 62 E 10.70 to a R.O. 3x, thence S 59 W 15.50 to a hickory 3x thence S 60 W 37 to a pine 3x on a branch, thence down the W borders of the creek to the beginning): together with all and singular the rights, Members he settlements and appurtenances to the same (belonging) or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Micajah Jordan, his heirs and assigns for ever, and here do hereby bind our selves, our heirs, executors, and administrators to warrant and favor defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Jordan, his heirs and assigns against our selves, and our heirs, and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming ~~the same~~ or any part thereof. Witness our hands and seals this the fifteenth of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
