The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents, that I John Medlock of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of three hundred dollars to me paid by Reuben Medlock of the same place. Have granted the said Reuben Medlock of the same place. Have granted the said Reuben Medlock all that plantation or tract of land containing eighty seven acres more or less, situate in the District aforesaid containing eighty seven acres more or less, situate in the District aforesaid lying on the Beaver dam, waters of Mountain Creek Beginning on a rock of a tree at a branch and running thence \$19.16 26.00 to a red Oak 3 ft bounded by the meanders of Joseph McCullough's land, thence 376 ft of 50 to a red Oak standing 3 ft thence to 1126.50 to a hogback 3 ft near the creek. Bounded by the said Medlock's land, then up the meanders of said creek on an elm 3 ft at the mouth of a branch thence up the meanders of said branch to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, hereunto belonging or in any wise incident. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Reuben Medlock his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Reuben Medlock, his heirs and assigns, against myself, and my heirs, and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming non to claim the same in any part thereof. Wtch my hand & seal this the second day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
