

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Jonathan Greenville District, Pollo Juner of the State and District aforesaid Have in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Ray of the State and District aforesaid Have granted bargained & sold unto the said James Ray all that tract of land on which the said now lives being situated in the State of South Carolina, and in Greenville District lying on the Devils Fork, the waters of the Middle fork of Saluda River, bounded by vacant land on three sides & by land of John Bytore on one side which land was conveyed from Jonathan Pollo Senior to me Jonathan Pollo Juner beginning on a red Oak, thence west to a pine, thence North to a poplar, thence East to a Chestnut Oak, thence to the beginning & cerna, containing one hundred acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Ray his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Ray his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal the eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty seven and in the sixtieth year of the Independence of the United States of America Jonathan Pollo Jr. (Seal)
