 bargain, sell, and deliver in plain and open market unto the said James Nash
 Negro man slave named Adam about 24 years of age. Together with all
 singular of the rest of my personal property to have and to hold all and singular
 to aforesaid premises and property unto the said James Nash his Heirs Executors
 Administrators and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof forever
 And I the said Thomas Nash do by these presents bind myself my Heirs Ex
 ecutors Administrators and assigns the said bargained premises & property unto the
 said James Nash, his Heirs and assigns to whomsoever it may belong, Provided
 notwithstanding, and it is expressly agreed between the said parties, that if the said
 Thomas Nash his Heirs Executors or Administrators, shall not make full payment on
 cause to be paid unto the said James Nash, his certain attorney Executors Adminis
 trators, or assigns, the full and just sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars, with the
 interest thereon before the 15th day of November next, then and in such case, and at
 all times from thence forth these presents, and all the estate real and personal herein
 granted and every article, clause or sentence herein contained or understood, shall
 cease, determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes, on thing herein con
 cerned to the contrary notwithstanding. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
