paid by William Choice Jr. of the same District the receipt where
of I do hereby acknowledge to have granted, bargained released sold &
conveyed and by these presents do grant, bargain, release, sell and con-
vey unto the said William Choice Jr. all that plantation or tract of
land situated in the District of Greenville. Beginning at a Stake
on the land John Bradley lately sold to the said William Choice
and by adorning N 60 E 23 to a Stake on the bank of Reedy River thence
down said River to a Stake on Elisha Green's line, thence S 10 E 023
to a red Oak corner and thence N 32 E 18 8 40. to the beginning
of a fence being the same land Conveyed to me by Allen R Perkins
now deceased dated the 24th day of June 1831 as the plot thereto annexed
will show, Containing Twenty acres more or less. Together with all
and singular the rights, Membles, hunddments and appurtenances to the
said land belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and
hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William
Choice Jr. and his heirs for ever. And I do hereby bind myself and my
successors, executors and administrators to remant and/or defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said William Choice Jr. against
adversaries, and my heirs and all and every other person or persons whomsoever
this claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and seal this the 10th day of November
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and in
the 52nd year of the Independence of the United States of America
John Crittenden and C. H. Walker sealed and delivered in the presence of
Jandy Walker Jefferson Choice.

The State of South Carolina came before me the subscriber
of the Greenville District, sealing Justice and being duly sworn deposed on
the 10th day that he was present and John Crittenden senior, seal and deliver the
aforesaid document to William Choice junior for the use and purposes thereon
and specified and that he together with Jandy Walker subscribed their names as
witnesses to the execution thereof, sworn and subscribed to before me the
