

Warrant South Carolina. I know all men by these presents that I, Andrew Patterson
 was to Summerville District 3 of the District and state aforesaid, for and in consideration of
 sum of One hundred Dollars to me paid by Elizabeth Bowen of the same
 State and District. Have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these pre-
 sents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Elizabeth Bowen a certain
 undivided tract of land containing fifty acres, situated in said District on both sides of the
Augusta road near the poor house and adjoining land belonging to the
 said Elizabeth, it being part of the tract of land, known by the name of
 Catt's mouth's Gun factory place, and formerly owned by Adam Garath deceased
 and does the part now to be conveyed have such bounds, Marks &c as follow: Beginning at
 John (beginning) at a stake 34 Pascals corner, thence N 36° E 11' 39" Chs to a stake,
 thence N 3 W 14 Chs to a Stake 34 on the line of
 Poor house lands, thence N 36° E 48.50 Chs to a stake 31 thence S 38° E
 11.75 Chs to the beginning corner together with all and singular the
 rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Elizabeth Bowen her heirs and
 assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever legally
 claiming or to claim the same for any part thereof. Witness my hand and

 hundred and Sixty Seven and Sixty second year of American Independence
