 and released and Conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell
 unto him the said James Gidley a certain tract or parcel of
 land, lying and being in the state and District aforesaid on both sides of the
 south fork of Mill creek waters of South Pacolet River, Beginning on a
 oak on the District line between Spartanburgh and Greenville Districts
 running thence S 56 W 45 chains and 50 links to a stake 3t thence N 16 38 e 60
 links to a red oak 3t, thence N 56 E 45 chains to a post oaks 3t, thence S 17 E
 60 chains 50 links to the beginning), Containing one hundred and twenty five acres
 the same more or less. To have and to hold, the above granted premises unto
 him the said James Gidley, his Heirs and Assigns forever. Together with all
 singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. And I the said Ben
 jamin Page, do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators
 and assigns forever to warrant and defend all and singular the before men
 tioned premises unto him the said James Gidley, his Heirs and Assigns, against
 myself, my Heirs and assigns, and against any and every other person or
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
