South Carolina. I, <sup>do</sup> know all men by these presents, that I Wardy McBee  
Greenville District, of Greenville District, in the state aforesaid, in consideration and upon  
of the sum of One hundred & fifty Dollars to me paid by Albert M. Spalding  
in the state aforesaid. Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Albert M. Spalding  
All that lot of land near Greenville Village, Beginning at a stake on Coffee  
Street a corner of said Albert M. Spalding's lot on which he now resides & runs  
thence along a line on the course of Coffee Street North 73 degrees West 179 1/2  
feet to a stake on the street or avenue leading from the Female Academy, thence  
North 21 degrees East a long a line of said Avenue 150 feet to a corner of Coopers  
Check's lot, thence south 73 degrees East 167 1/2 feet along a line of said  
Check's lot to a stake, thence South 17 degrees West a long a line of said  
Albert M. Spalding's lot 150 feet to the beginning be the same more or less  
within the above described bounds. Together with all and singular  
the rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Albert M. Spalding  
his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs  
Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all lands singular  
in the said premises, unto the said Albert M. Spalding his Heirs and  
assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight  
hundred and thirty eight and in the sixty second year of the Independence  
of the United States of America. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence  
of Moses S. Bingham and Joseph Headden.

mises within mentioned released, given under my hand & seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of Feb 1838
