The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents, that I Charles Greenville District ³⁸² Garrison sen^r of the State and District aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Elias C Garrison of the same place, have granted bargained, sold and released & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elias C Garrison all that plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred & twenty five acres more or less lying in the State and District aforesaid, and on which the said Elias C now lives immediately on the south side of Saluda River just before Wilson's Ferry on said river Beginning on a post Oak 3^t on the road side thence a long sd road N 54 E 29 1/4 to a young pine 3^t thence S 29 E 16.50 to Stake & rock 3^t in an old road thence S 51 E 14.20 across the tanyard branch to a stake 3^t thence S 38 W. 6.10. to a Stake and rock 3^t thence S 48 E. 21 Ch^s to a post Oaks dead now Stake 3^t, thence S 41 W 50 Ch 12 links to a red oaks 3^t thence S 79 W. 8.36 to a post oak 3^t thence N 70 1/2 E 5.25 to white oak 3^t thence N 47 W. 4 Ch^s to a hickory 3^t on river at the mouth of a small branch, thence up the meanders of said river to a maple 3^t close to the water thence N 47 W. 4 chains 60 links to the beginning Post oak 3^t.
