South Carolina <sup>3</sup> Know all men by these presents, that I Hardy  
Greenville District <sup>3</sup> I Gilreath of the District and State aforesaid  
for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred Dollars to me in  
hand paid, by Jesse B Wallace of the District and State aforesaid  
and John H Campbell of the District of Laurence & State aforesaid  
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wallace & Campbell  
all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres be  
the same more or less, it being the upper part of a tract of land gran-  
ted to William Savage containing  $\frac{1}{4}$  hundred & eighteen acres  
situate lying and being as follows viz in the District & State aforesaid  
in said on a branch of Enore River and branches of thist. <sup>W</sup> m dam creek a  
branch of South Tiger River, bounded by lines running NW by Rocklands lands  
& N.E. & E & S.W by Styles lands, W by Kelly's land known of late by the name  
of Cross places where the District road crosses the Buncum road, references  
may be had to a deed from John Miller to John Wood, also all that tract or  
parcel of land containing One hundred acres, more or less, situate lying and being  
in the District and State aforesaid adjoining the above mentioned one hundred  
acres of land references for conveyances and boundaries to a deed from Robert D.  
Moore to Hardy I Gilreath, also all the right title and claim that I the  
aforesaid Hardy I Gilreath have to a certain tract or parcel of land supposed  
to contain two hundred acres more or less situate lying and being in  
the District and State aforesaid on the waters of Shadus Buncum  
creek a branch of South Tiger River bounded by lands of Tho Wadswor  
now occupied by Stephen Marchbanks on the N on the W by lands  
now owned by J Westmoreland, on the SW by lands of Samuel Syly

Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditament,  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-  
cluded or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the pre-  
mises before mentioned unto the said Wallace & Campbell their heirs  
and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and  
Administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and  
singular (except the last mentioned two hundred acres of land who
