

## The State of South Carolina

I John Moon of the District of Greenville, and State aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by Abner Moon of Greenville in the District, and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold & released and singularly by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Abner Moon his assigns all that tract or parcel of Land containing One hundred Acres, be the same more or less, Situate lying and being in the District & State aforesaid on the North side of Enoree River, beginning on the bank of said River on Perry's line, on an wood running thence N<sup>o</sup>. 40 E to a stake, thence N<sup>o</sup>. 63 S W to a cherry tree on Samuel Gibson's line, thence on Gibsons line to South where said line intersects Perry's line, thence on Perry's line S 10 E to a Summit a Hickory, thence S 15 W to a post Oak, thence S. 10 E to said Enoree David River where said Perry's line crosses the same, thence up the Meanderance to of the River to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned, unto the said Abner Moon his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said Abner Moon his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs & against every other person or person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord 1838. and of the Sovereignty & Independence of the United States the Sixty second. Signed sealed & acknowledged in the presence of Pleasant Moon John Styles John Moon (Seal)

South Carolina personally came before me the Subscribing Justice of Greenville District, John L Styles and made oath that he saw John Moon sign Seal and acknowledge the within deed of Conveyance to Abner Moon to less for the use and purposes within mentioned, and that he saw Pleasant Moon appear as a witness to the same with himself sworn to before John L Styles the this 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1838.
