 I, John Henson of the same State & District
 have granted, bargained and sold unto James Henson of the state and
 District above certain lot or tract of land, containing by estimation
 Sixty seven acres more or less, beginning, on a maple on the bank of
 the River Middle Tigr, thence S. 82° E 5 ch 50 links to a Spanish Oak
 and thence N. 24° E. 16 ch 50 links to a white Oak on Atkins line, thence
 with s^d line N. 35° W 20 c 25 links to a stump, thence S. 82° W 15 c to
 a black Oak, thence S. 6 W. 15 ch to a black Oak on the bank of the
 River, thence S. 52° E crossing the turn of C to an ash on the bank
 of the River of the River, thence down said River as it meanders
 to the beginning corner containing sixty seven acres be the same
 more or less for the consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars
 to me in hand paid by James Henson. Together with all and
 singular, the above mentioned premises unto the said James Henson
 his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my
 heirs and assigns to wear at and for ever defend the said premises
 unto the said James Henson his heirs and assigns against myself
 my heirs and assigns and against all and every other person or
 persons claiming the same, or any part thereof. In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day 30 in
 the year of Our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty eight
 Independence, Sixty second & Sixty third
 Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us, John Henson
 Test, W. McLoon Test. William Henson Jr.
 J. H. Henson Jr.

In South Carolina personally came William McLoon before the
 Greenville District, subscribing Justice, and made oath in due form
 of law that he was personally present when the written Deed of convey
 ance was signed and sealed & that William Henson Junr. did subscribe
 being witness unto himself to the due execution of the same. I worn to
