State of South Carolina, I Know all men by these presents, that I James Alexander Greenville District, Son of said State and District for and in Consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me paid by James Alexander Junior of the said State and District have granted, bargained and sold and do by these presents, grant, bargain sell release and deliver unto the said James Alexander Junior a piece parcel or tract of land Containing 194 acres be the same more or less being part of a tract of land which was originally granted to John Vickly lying and being in the State of South Carolina and District of Greenville and Situate on the waters of the Quaw branch and Cripple creek of Reedy river & bounded as follows. Beginning at a post oak 3x and running thence N 35° 4' chains to a post oak 3x, thence N 54° 30' E 17 ch to a hickory 3x thence S 35° W 13, 50 to a post oak 3x at the head of the Quaw branch, thence N 50° 15' W 11, 50 to a willow 3x on the said branch, thence down the same to J. Thompson's line to an ash 3x n m thence S 26° 30' W 36 ch 70 L to a rock newly set up thence N 65 W 865 to a rock formerly on J Brasier's but now on James Gaull's line thence S 26. 30 W. 17. 25 to a rock on the said J Gaull's line thence S 65 E 40 19 to a sassafras on Jquin Alexander's line, thence N 16 E 9. 19 to a red oak 3x n m. thence S 73° 45 E 840 to a red oak at muddy branch on the Greenville road thence up the same road N 17 E 17. 09 to the beginning and to contain One hundred and Ninety-four acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights little interests and appurtenances there unto belonging or in anywise incident appertaining I do have and to hold the said Bargained premises unto the said James Alexander Junior his heirs executors Administrators and assigns to his and their proper use and behoof for ever.
