of Greenville District, John Couch of the District of Pickens
and George W Hyde of the District of Greenville and both of the state
aforesaid in consideration of four hundred Dollars to us paid by
Ebenezer Gower of Greenville District in the state aforesaid have granted
bargained bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Ebenezer Gower all that tract
lot and parcel of land situate lying and being situate in the
village of Greenville, being the same which was purchased of
Padron McPhee by John Couch on the 7th day of March 1820 and
described in said McPhee's plan of the village and known as number
(18) eighteen beginning at the South West corner of lot Number fifteen
and running longside said lot South fourteen degrees east one hundred
and seventy six feet and one fourth to the south west corner of lot number
Sixteen thence along Number Nineteen South sixteen degrees west
one hundred feet to the corner of Number nineteen and twenty one,
Hence North seventy four degrees west one hundred and seventy six, and
one forth feet to the North West corner of lot number twenty on the
main street, thence along the main street North sixteen degrees east
one hundred feet to the beginning and conveyed by deed to George W
Hyde b. John Couch, on the fifth day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, the said John Couch
then taking a deed from the said W Hyde a mortgage of the said premises
of equal date with the deed aforesaid to secure to him the purchase money of
said lot of land above described together with all and singular the rights
members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Ebenezer Gower his heirs and
assigns for ever and we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs & executors
and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Ebenezer Gower his heirs and assigns
against our selves and our heirs and against every person wholsowever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and
in the sixty first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the
