thence N 52° W 1 Chain 55 links P O Stump thence N 88° W 6-50 to a red
Oak stump by a spring, thence S 70° W 1.70 to a red Oak, thence N 69° W 3ch
a post Oak, thence S 108° W 370 to the beginning containing by estimation
in 15 ³/₄ acres Together with all and singular the rights, members, and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appur-
