South Carolina. I know all men by these presents that I, Jordon Holcombe of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and eighty Dollars in hand paid by Josiah Langford of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof so hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, confirm and convey unto the said Josiah Langford, all that plantation, tract or parcel of land containing two hundred & fifteen acres more or less situate, lying and being in the State and District aforesaid on branches of the sink hole fork of Tiger River, beginning at a state corner, and running thence West, twenty seven chains and fifty six links to a post oak, thence North twenty three east, thirty one ch., and fifty six links to another post oak, thence North ten East nine ch. to a white Oak, thence East Forty eight ch., and fifty links to a white Oak. Thence South, Eleven West Twenty nine ch. and fifty six links to a hickory, thence South forty five east, twelve ch., and seventy five links to a rock or a chestnut (now), thence South twenty west, fourteen ch. and fifty six links to a red Oak. Thence North Eighty three West, twenty seven chains and fifty six links to a chestnut, thence North, thirty five east, three ch. to the beginning bearing of a tract of land granted to the said Jordon Holcombe bearing date June fifth, one thousand seven hundred eighty five, and also a certain tract of land granted to the said Jordon Holcombe bearing date December second One thousand Eight hundred and eleven and part of a tract
