Know all men by these presents that Stephen Howard of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars to me in hand paid by Stephen Howard of the District and State aforesaid have bargained sold and released and by these presents doth bargain sell and release unto the said Stephen Howard all that plantation or tract of Land on which he now lives containing one hundred and fifty two acres more or less situated in the District aforesaid and Branch of Currahee Creek, Beginning at John Howard's Stake 3x, and running on his S. 165 E 23, 50 to a Stake 3x, then N 115 E 61, 50 to a B.C. 3x, C.B. Canadian corner then on his line N 30 W. 4, 50 to a Stake, & thence S. 61, 50 to a Post oak 3x 4, 25 W. 10 to a Stake, S. 45 W. 44, 50 to the Beginning Together with all and singular the rights, privileges hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold and to singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Stephen Howard Howard his heirs or assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself myself my executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Stephen Howard Howard his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part hereof is writing whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3d day in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Thirteen, Eighteen hundred and forty three in fee simple of
