 consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Sixty Dollars to me in hand  
 paid (the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged by John M. Johnson of the  
 State and District aforesaid) have bargained sold and released and by these  
 presents do bargain sell release and confirm unto the said John M. Johnson his  
 heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and situate in the  
 District aforesaid on the Beaverdam Creek waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda  
 River and containing by measurement One hundred Acres and laid off to the  
 said John M. Johnson as follows viz Beginning at a Rock xiii running S.  
 89° W. 14 Chains on Mr. Clark's to a Rock corner xiii thence N 81 E. 50 Chains  
 John M. Davids to a Post oak xiii thence N. 10. W. 28 Chains on said. 142  
 vid to a rock xiii thence due N. 37 Chains on John Kerby to the beginning  
 corner. It being a part of a tract of Land of 3000 acres sold by Rowson  
 Cobb to Vincent Austin, Together with all and singular the rights -  
 members hereditaments and appertinances therunto belonging or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and  
 singular the said bargained premises unto the said John M. Johnson  
 his heirs and assigns and I the said Henry G Johnson do for myself  
 of my heirs Executors and Administrators warrant and forever defend the  
 said bargained premises unto the said John M. Johnson his heirs  
 and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against every  
 other person claiming the same or any part thereof, witness  
 my hand and seal the fourteenth day of November Eighteen hundred  
 and thirty seven and in the sixtieth year of American Independence  
 signed sealed and delivered in presence
