in the District of Greenville one of Hargans Creek off Tiger River  
Beginning at a Poplar Corner on the Creek running then east  
to a Condition a Line agreed on by Clabourn Johnson and Zachariah  
Hyatt which Line is to run a Crook the corner of the Land belonging  
to the Estate of Clabourn Johnson Deed Executed with the Crook made  
made Between Ad Johnson Deed & Hyatt thence with the  
Direction of the former to the Creek thence with the meander  
of the Creek to the Beginning Supposed to Contain fifty  
acres be the same more or less it being Part off a tract of Land  
Belonging to the Estate of Clabourn Johnson Deceased  
Together with all and Singular the said premises its  
incidents Predicaments appurtenances to have and to hold all and  
Singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jesse  
Philip his Heirs and Assigns forever and we do hereby bind our  
Selves Our Heirs Executors and Administrators to defend and  
forever defend all and Singular the said Premises against  
Our selves Our Heirs Executors and Administrators or any  
or persons lawfully claiming as to claim the same for any
