South Carolina; Know all men by these presents, Greenville District 3 that I John J Dodd of the County of Rutherford and State of North Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by William Neves of Greenville District and State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, released, and conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto him the said William Neves a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina on both sides of Mill Creek waters of South Tiger River and bounded as follows. Beginning at a Hickory corner of John Nicols old Survey, running thence North 30° W. 34 Chains to a Hickory thence S. 75° W. 1 Chain 30 links to a Stake thence N 9° W. 4 Chains 38 links to R. Oak 3 X thence N. 22° W. 13 Chains to a Stake at a Branch thence down the meanders of said Branch to Mill Creek thence down the meanders of the Creek to the mouth of a dry ditch thence crossing the Creek and running along said Ditch N 31° E. 9 Chains 75 Links to a Stake at another ditch thence along said Ditch S. 56° E. 12 Chains to an angle in the same thence along the same Ditch S. 68° E. 6 Chains 50 Links to a Stake Fowlers corner then along Fowlers line 1147 W. 6 chains to the mouth of another Ditch thence along said Ditch S. 27° W. 16 Chains to a Stake at a Creek thence along the edge of a swamp including the same to a dead white Oak 3 X thence N 48° W. 6 Chains to a Stake thence S. 58° W. 13, 50 Chains to a Red Oak 3 X thence 62 W. 16 Chains 75 Links to the Beginning Containing two hundred and seventy acres be the same more or less.

To Have and To Hold the above granted Premises unto him the said William Neves his Heirs and Assigns forever Together with all and Regular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, therunto belonging or in any wise incidental or appertaining. And I the Said Jno Dodd do hereby bind myself my heirs and Assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted premises unto him the said William Neves his heirs and Assigns against myself my heirs and Assigns and against any and every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof who witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix
