Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident thereto or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said E. R. Earle her Heirs and Assigns, forever. And I do hereby bind myself, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Elizabeth R. Earle her Heirs and assigns against myself and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
