South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Elijah Dill of Greenville District State and district aforesaid in consideration of the good will and respect I have for my son James M Dill do give, grant and Convey unto him, his heirs, Executrix, or Administrators a small tract of land containing forty acres and a half situate and being in the District and State aforesaid on the waters of Beaver Dam Creek waters of South Tyger River bounded as follows Viz: Beginning on a Poplar corner on the South West side of sd Creek thence N 65 W 24 50 chs to Spanish Oak & 3 thence S 45 E 19 40 chs to a stone & 3 thence N 51 E 5 75 chs to a stone corner & 3 thence N 49 E 22 chs to a Maple & 3 on the sd Creek, thence up the Meanders of the Creek to the beginning 15 chs to have and to hold all the above granted premises unto him the said James M Dill his heirs and assigns forever together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to it, and I the said Elijah Dill do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns to warrant and defend the same against myself, my heirs Executors and Assigns and against any person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth February One thousand Eight hundred and thirty nine signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
