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The State of South Carolina - Know all men by these presents that Peter Lenderman of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on Consideration of Two Hundred and Ninety Two Dollars fifty cents to me in hand paid by Henry Lenderman of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Lenderman all that tract or parcel of land situated in Greenville District on the fork Shoal Road immediately above McPollards beginning on a stake on the said Road N 36 E 10. 86 to a Red Oak thence N 56 W 16. 75 to a stake thence S 31 W 17. or to a small Hickory thence S 31 E to a post oak thence N 47 E 14. 20 to a post oak on the road thence up the meadry said road to the beginning bounded on the lower end by land belonging to Mayfield Peter Lenderman, James Lenderman Hance Black land having such shapes and form as the plat will most fully represent containing fifty eight acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and purtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Lenderman his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Lenderman his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against every other person whosoever claiming the same or part thereof
