nd thence N 67 E 7 to a stake at a branch thence down the meanders of said
branch to Mountain Creek bounded by the said Hones land thence N 76 E 48.80
to a stake at the lower dam creek thence up the said creek N 10 W 12.00 thence
N 11 E 10.00 thence North 7.00 to a stake 3x thence N 33 W 16.50 to the begi-
