 Greenville District } Greenville District in the state aforesaid in consideration
 of the sum of six thousand two hundred and ten Dollars to me in hand paid by
 Blackman Sigon of Greenville District in the state aforesaid have granted, bargained,
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
 said Blackman Sigon All that parcel or tract of Land situate lying and being
 in the Town of Greenville in Greenville District and State aforesaid known as Lot
 No 17 in the plan of the Village reference being thenceunto had for a more particular
 Description it being the lot whereon the Carolina Hotel now stands containing
 one hundred and fifty feet fronting Main Street, and two hundred and thirty five feet
 fronting Washington Street one hundred and forty feet fronting on west side Laurence
 street and two hundred and thirty five feet from Laurence Street to Main Street
 On the North side bounded by lot No 19 known by the plan of said Village; also
 all of the two lots known in the plan of said Village as Numbers (18 & 20) containing
 two hundred and forty feet fronting on the east on Laurence Street and two hundred
 feet in depth to Richardson Street being the lots whereon the Stables attached to the
 Carolina Hotel establishment now stand and bounded on the North by Coffee
 Street also the balance of the Lot No 19 conveyed to said Green by W. J. Rowland
 as the balance of the lot not conveyed by him to Peter Caulte and excepting the
 store house and Ground now occupied by Greenway & Beattie together with a suff-
 icient eve drop to said House which which lot is bounded on the North by Coffee
 Street on the west by Laurence Street and on the East by main Street and
 on the south by lot No 17 on the west side of said Village as laid down in
 the plan aforesaid reference to which being had for shape of said lot.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurten-
 ances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining;
 I have and to hold, all and singular the premises beforementioned unto the
 said Blackman Sigon his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever
 defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said Blackman
 Sigon his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs and against
 every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof - Witness my Hand and seal this twenty first day of February in the
 Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine, and in the
 sixty third Year of the Independence of the United States of America - signed sealed
