by this presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the s^r John M^r Harrison
a certain tract or parcel of land containing thirty seven acres situate in
Greenwell District and State aforesaid on the waters of Rayburns Creek
being a part of a tract of land originally granted to David Peden by
his excellency Charles Pinckney containing nine hundred and ten acres the
2nd day of March 1792 - Beginning at a Stake 3⁺ thence N 4.30 to a
Red Oak 3⁺ thence S 65 W 12.50 to a Rock 3⁺ N 15 W 16.70 to a Rock 3⁺
thence S 65 W 1.55 to a sour wood 3⁺ thence N 55 E 23 to a stake 3⁺ thence
S 25 to the beginning - Together with all and singular the rights mem-
bers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging to
or in anywise incident or appertaining I have and do hold, all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said John M^r Harrison his heirs & assigns
forever And I do truly bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the s^r John M^r Harrison
his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs Executors Administrators & assigns
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand
and seal the 21st day of December One thousand eight hundred and thirty
