The State of South Carolina - Know all men by these presents that I James Mayfield of Spartanburgh Dist and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Philip C Lester of the Dist of Greenville & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain & release unto Philip C Lester a tract or parcel of land containing one Hundred and eleven Acres more or less situate in Spartanburgh Dist on the south side of Rockyfield Creek Beginning on a B.C. 3+ on the N side of said Creek thence N. 55 to a stake 3+ thence N. 24 to B.C. 3+ thence E. 38 to to Beet. 3+ on the N. side of said Creek then down the meanders of said Creek to the beginning which includes all the land to be conveyed Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises as before mentioned unto the S^d Phil C Lester to him his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the S^d premises unto the S^d Phil C Lester his heirs & assigns against myself & heirs & against every other person or person whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in Witness my hand & seal this 10th day of November A.D. 1832 and in the fifty seventh year of American Independence
