 and affection which I have and bear unto my Daughter Elizabeth Rice and also  
 for divers other good causes and considerations - I the said John Ashmore sr. have  
 given granted and confirmed and by these presents do give grant and confirm  
 unto the said Elizabeth Rice all and singular my rights and claim to a negro  
 girl named Harriet together with One cow & calf One bed & furniture in  
 whose hands custody or possession soever they may be. to have hold and enj-  
 -oy all and singular the said goods chattels and personal estate aforesaid  
 unto the said Elizabeth Rice and the lawful heirs of her body to the only proper  
 use and behoof of the same forever And I the said John Ashmore sr. do give  
 and grant and convey all and singular the said goods chattels & personal  
 Estate to the said Elizabeth Rice and to the lawful heirs of her body against  
 myself my Executor and Administrators and all and every other person or  
 persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents  
 all and singular the said goods chattels and personal estate and I the said  
 John Ashmore have put the said Elizabeth Rice in full possession by  
 delivering to her the said property at the signing <sup>sealing</sup> of these presents in the  
 name of the whole property hereby granted In Witness whereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand and seal this 25 of November 1830

 of land containing thirty nine acres more or less situate in the district  
 of Greenville aforesaid on both sides of the Trail Road it being part  
 of a tract of land originally granted to Jonathan Dewese and hath such  
 bounds &c. as follows. (viz) Beginning at a stake 3+ near the aforesaid  
 road thence S 10 W 17 chs. to a stake 3+ thence S. 72 E 23.50 to a small Pine 3+  
 thence N 10 E 16 chs to a stake on the back or original line thence with that  
 line N 41 W 23 chs to the beginning corner Together with all and singular  
 the rights members Inheritments or appurtenances to the said premises
