 Greenville District 3 Micajah Jordan of the State and District  
 aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ninety five Dollars fifty  
 Cents to me in hand paid by Joseph McCullough of the same place  
 have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph McCullough  
 all that Plantation or tract of Land, containing Thirty three acres  
 (more or less), situate in the District aforesaid lying on the waters of  
 Mountain Creek, beginning on a Chesnut 34 and running thence S 80  
 E 14.00 to a Rock 34, thence S. 88 E 21.45 to a Rock 34, bounded by William Stokes  
 land thence N 33 E 9.50 to a Stone 34, thence N 72 W 23.00 to a Rock 34, on the  
 Creek, thence down the meanderings of the Creek to the Beginning Corner  
 bounded by the said Micajah Jordan. Together with all and singular  
 the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. Do I have and do hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph  
 McCullough his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend  
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCullough  
 his heirs and assigns forever, against myself and my heirs and against  
 every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
