

South Carolina ³ I know all men by these presents that I Greenville District ³ Meajah Jordan of the State and District aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixty five Dollars fifty cents to me in hand paid by Joseph McCullough of the same place have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph McCullough all that Plantation or tract of Land, containing Thirty three acres more or less, situated in the District aforesaid lying on the water of Mountain Creek, beginning on a Chestnut tree and running thence S^o E 14° 00 to a Rock ³ then S. 48 E 21.45 to a rock ³ bounded by William Jones land thence N 34 E 9.50 to a stone ³, thence N 72 W 23.00 to a rock ³, on the Creek, thence down the meanderings of the Creek to the Beginning corner bounded by the said Meajah Jordan. Together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and assigns forever, against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
