do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Nelson  
Gilreath all that Tract or parcels of Land containing One  
Hundred and six the same more or less, lying and being  
in the District and State aforesaid on the South fork of Broad  
River beginning on Abraham Nelsons corner thence run-  
ning on J. Moores line to a Post oak corner on Lewis Cauds  
line thence running on Cauds line to a Stake corner on the  
said South fork of Broad River, thence down its meander  
to the beginning together with all and singular the rights  
members and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurten-  
-ing. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
Administrators and assigns to forever warrant & defend  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Nelson Gilreath his heirs and assigns forever  
against myself my heirs Executors administrators  
and assigns and against all and every other person  
or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or  
any part thereof in witness whereof I hereunto set my
