 bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant & defend  
 all & singular the said premises unto the said Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee his heirs and  
 assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or  
 persons uponsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

 of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for & in consideration of the sum  
 of Seven hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee  
 the Receipt and Payment of which sum is hereby fully acknowledged  
 I have bargained & sold and delivered unto the said Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee  
 a certain negro boy named Peter about twelve years of age of yellow  
 complexion who has worked some in the Tan Yard which negro boy  
 I hereby warrant and forever defend against myself my heirs and  
 against the claim of Every other whatsoever to the said Vardry M<sup>r</sup> Bee  
 his heirs and assigns for ever & to be sound & healthy free from any bodily or  
 mental defect whatsoever. In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal  
 this 23 day of December 1839
