

and agree to and with the said David Long his executors administrators and assigns by these presents that if default shall happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum of Thirteen hundred dollars as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the conditions of the bond that then and ⁱⁿ such case it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said David Long his executors administrators attorneys or agents from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into and upon all the messuages lands or tenements of the said Robert Wilson and to take the said Negroe man Elias into his custody and possession and the same to hold and detain to his own use and benefit his own proper goods and chattels) from hence forth and forever ~~as the~~ same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure, returning the overplus if any should happen to be after paying the said sum of thirteen hundred dollars with the lawfull interest thereon according to the conditions of the bond aforesaid, unto the said Robert Wilson his executors administrators or assigns.
