Together with all & singular the rights members Mereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the undivided half of the premises before mentioned unto the said John W. Lewis his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the undivided half of the premises unto the said John W. Lewis his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against all and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
