

Greenville District } that J. Matthias Rush of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Abraham P. Hardin of the State and district aforesaid the receipt and payment are hereby acknowledged. The said Rush hath bargained and sold and conveyed unto the said Hardin his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the said State and District on the waters of Middle Tyger and South Packett rivers lying round the cross roads Meeting House adjoining land of John Vaughn Silas W. Whittow Jeremiah Henson & others Beginning on a post Oak on John Vaughns line thence with said line N 70 45 chains to a white Oak Whittows corner thence with his line N 75 28 chains to a post Oak thence S 30 11 chains 50 links to a black Oak thence E. 13 chs. 50 links to a black Oak thence N 60 22 chains 50 links to a white Oak thence S. 33 chains to a pine on the Old Georgia road thence S 20 45 chains to a Red Oak thence N. 82 W. 56 chains to a spanish Oak thence N 18 West 16 chs to a Post Oak on the said road thence West with the road to a Post Oak near Jeremiah Hensons on the North side of the road thence to the beginning containing by estimation Four hundred acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to the same or in anywise incident or appertaining
