


a small parcel of land from Joseph Evans bearing date the 14th

Beginning at a post Oak on John Vaughns line thence with
said line 498 45 chains to a white Oak Whitters corner thence
with his line 475 8 28 chains to a post Oak thence 530 8 11 chains
50 links to a black Oak thence E. 13 chs. 50 links to a black Oak
thence 460 6 22 chains 50 links to a white Oak thence 5.33 chains to
a pine on the Old Georgia road thence 520 8 45 chains to a Red Oak
thence N. 82 W. 56 chains to a Spanish Oak thence N 18 West 16 chs.
to a Post Oak on the said road thence West with the road to a
Post Oak near Jeremiah Henderson on the North side of the
