 unto the said Edmund Waddell his Heirs and assigns & forever
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Edmund Waddell his heirs and assigns against
 me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
