Roberts of the District of Greenville State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars to us in hand paid by John Watson Junior of the District & State above mentioned have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Watson Jr. a certain tract of ~~xxx~~ ^{xx} piece or parcel of land containing forty five acres be the same more or less lying and being in the District & State aforesaid on waters of Saluda River Beginning at a State corner on John Shapards land near the public Road running thence N⁴⁸E. 17 to a bunch of Poplars on H. Toals land thence down the Creek of High Water Marsh nearly to its intersection with Mill Creek thence S¹⁰E. 7.50 to an ash tree N⁵⁰ W 2.50 to a State thence N⁸¹W. 11 to a State thence S⁵⁰W 3.50 to a State thence N³³W 3 to intersection with Ditch thence up the Ditch line 11 chains to a Maple thence N⁷²E 18 to the Beginning State corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said John Watson Jr. his heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs Exec. & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Watson Jr. his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
