To all to whom these presents shall come David
Hemming Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid send greet-
ing. Whereas by virtue of Sundry Writs of fieri facias issued out
of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested
the Ninth day of March in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight
and thirty nine at the suit of Lewis Gibson & others to me directed
commanding me that of the Goods and chattels lands and tenements
of Joseph Powell to levy the sum of Five thousand six hundred dollars
damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands & tenements
of the said Joseph Powell all that certain piece parcel and tract of
land situate and being in the District of Greenville and State
aforesaid. Beginning on a Stake on Avenue and the 40 feet Street
and run S. 74 E. 300 feet along Avenue Street to a Stake on another Street
40 Feet wide thence N 16 E along the 40 feet Street 300 feet to a Stake thence
N 70 W. 300 feet to a Stake thence S 16 W along the Street to the Beginning
on Avenue Street including 2 Lots as described in the deed from
M^c Bee to Anderson and lying East of the Square occupied by
Joseph Powell. And whereas the said premises with their appurten-
ances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writs of fieri
facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue
and purchased by Benjamin G. Perry the District and State
aforesaid for the sum of Five Dollars being the highest sum that was
