Greeting. Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the
Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville testudo the
the seventh day of November in the year of Our Lord One thousand
Eight hundred and Thirty eight at the suit of L. H. Dickey to me
directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and
tenements of Josiah D. Landford to levy the sum of Three hundred &
seventy five dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the
lands and tenements of the said Josiah D. Landford all that certain
piece parcel and tract of land containing Two hundred & fifteen acres
more or less situate and being in the District of Greenville and State
aforesaid in branches of Middle Tyger River and bounded as follows
to wit. Beginning on a state corner running thence N. 37 chains
50 links to a post Oak thence N. 23 E. 31 chains 50 links to a Hickory
thence N. 10 E. 9 chains to a White Oak thence 848 chains 450 links to
a White Oak thence S. 11 W. 29 chains and 50 links to a Hickory then
S. 45 E. 12 chains and 75 links to a chestnut (new) thence S. 75. W. 14 ch.
and 50 links to a red Oak thence N. 83 W. 37 chains and 50 links to
a chestnut thence N. 35 E. 3 chains to the Beginning which said tract
of land was mortgaged to Gordon Hodges for the payment of
Three hundred and eighty dollars and which mortgage has been
satisfied by the said L. H. Dickey as will be seen by his receipt for the
same. And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances
