Whereas by virtue of sundry writs of fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the ninth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine at the suit of Amsted Roman & others to me directed commanding me that of the Goods & chattels lands and tenements of Samuel W. Watson to pay the sum of Nine hundred and seventeen dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Samuel W. Watson all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing five hundred & seventy nine ¹⁴⁷ acres more or less situate and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid being all the tract of land whereon
