 assigns part of a tract of land laying on North Patow Creek. Originally  
 granted to John M. Knight, containing eighty acres be the same more or  
 less in the district aforesaid beginning on a Pine Station running S. 20. E. 60  
 to post Oak thence S 70 W 24 to a Hickory thence N 44 W 29 to a White  
 Oak Station thence E. Peden's line to the beginning. Together with all &  
 singular the rights members and Appurtenances thereof to the said tract  
 of land being or in anywise belonging or Appertaining and Remainder  
 rents and profits thereof And of every part thereof to have and to
