Now know ye that I Asa W. Crowder Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fier facias aforesaid to the directed and delivered as aforesaid. and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said William Coney the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold unto the said William Coney his heirs and assigns for ever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title interest which the said Willis Hicks of right had of in and to the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said William Coney his heirs and assigns for ever as fully and absolutely as the said Asa W. Crowder might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fier facias or otherwise In witness whereof I the said Asa W.
