which may be claimed by either of us to Mr. James Pickett, the
Rev. Jefferson Barton and the said John Watson, and we the
aforesaid Walton Staton, Daniel Pace and Iquire Morgan do hereby
bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors,
Adm^{rs} to stand to and abide by the decisions and award of the
above named referee, witness our hands and seals the day¹ year
above written signed, sealed, and delivered in presence of

Youth Carolinas *W^m James Pickett, Jefferson Barton & John*
Greenville District *J. Watson having been chosen by Walton Staton*
Iquire Morgan and Daniel Pace to settle some conflicting claims
to lands situate in said district on Fall Creek of the North
fork of Saluda River do hereby award unto all the said Walton
Staton all that portion of his claim in the grant made to John Landale
on both sides of the said Creek except fourteen acres, viz. Beginning
at a Chestnut tree of said Landale's survey on the north side of said
creek thence N 68° E 29 chs to a Stake thence N 68 E 10 chs to a Stone
thence N 68 W 28.50 chs to the beginning which fourteen acres
we award to the said Morgan. The said Daniel Pace is to have
sufficient time to gather the present crop and remove it off his
claim at which time all his claim under the grant made to
W^m Rupel contained within the boundary of the Grant to the
said Landale to cease, and no further claim to be set up by
him or his heirs or assigns to said land. The aforesaid fourteen
acres to be all the land the said Morgan his heirs or
assigns is to claims of the grant made to W^m Rapp. Given
