Gunnels of the same district & state aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell release & convey unto the said William C. Gunnels all that piece or parcel of land containing two hundred acres (more or less) situate in the district & state aforesaid on the North East side of Martin's Creek bounded by lands of William Nistek, Dempsey Nistek & Jeremiah Hopkins & Martin's Creek being part of a tract of land formerly owned by George Martin (Dec 25) Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining:

To have & to hold all & singular the aforesaid premises unto the said William C. Gunnels his heirs & assigns. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the aforesaid premises unto the said William C. Gunnels his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against the claim of all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Whereas I am indebted by Bond bearing date with these presents unto the said William C. Gunnels in the sum of Two thousand dollars conditioned for the payment of one thousand dollars in nine installments as stated in said bond as will fully appear by reference thereto

Now it is understood & is upon express condition that upon the payment of the said sum of one thousand dollars at the times & upon times of the said bond that this conveyance & every clause & article hereof contained to cease determining & be utterly null & void otherwise to remain & continue in full force & effect.
