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Know all men by these presents that I Henry H. Ferry of the State  
of South Carolina and Greenville District in consideration of one  
hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid. the receipt here by ac-  
knowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by those  
Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Alfred Turner of  
South Carolina Greenville District his heirs and assigns a certain tract  
or parcel of land containing three hundred and seventeen Acres more  
or less situated in Greenville District on both sides of the Meadow  
forks of Marsh Creek and bounded as follows. Viz. Beginning  
on a Red Oak on Leonard Clayburn's and Shirell's conditional line  
thence S. 52 W. 4 chains to a Post Oak thence S. 40 W. 38.51 crossing  
said Creek to Red Oak on William Calloway's line thence with said  
line 8 chains to Poplar on a branch thence up said branch with  
its meanders 15 chains to a Maple thence to a Chestnut on the Ridge  
between Grimes Holcombe and John Forrest thence N. 11 E. 15  
to a Black Gum on said Creek crossing the same. N. 3 W. 4.50 to a  
White Oak and - - - Rock in a Sheaf of a Branch. thence S.  
48 E. 30.50 to a Spanish Oak on said Creek crossing the same  
N. 15 E. 37.50 to a Post Oak on the Ridge Path that leads from  
Leonard Clayburn's towards New Market thence S. 55 E. 19.50 with  
said path to a Red Oak thence to the beginning it being part of  
Sunday tracts of land conveyed to John Crawford by Richard Forrest  
and Thomas Edwards as the records of Greenville will now fully  
make it appear. Together with all and singular the right to man-  
bers hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all  
and singular the land and premises before mentioned unto the  
said Alfred Turner his heirs and assigns for ever and I the said  
Henry Ferry do hereby bind myself my heirs my executors  
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said land and premises to said Turner his heirs and  
assigns against myself my heirs and any other person or persons  
lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof  
My hand and Seal this the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 1832
