Greenville District } that I John S. Coleman of the
District and State aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of thirty six dollars to me paid by John Wat-
son of the said State and district have granted, bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant, barga-
in sell and release unto the said John Watson his
heirs and assigns forever tract or piece of land containing
six Acres, more or less situate in said district on
Waters of Saluda River adjoining lands of said Watson
it being part of a tract of land originally surveyed for
William Young and having such boundaries, marks &c as follows
(viz) Beginning at a Maple 3x near the head of a branch
hence N 38° E 8.50 chs to a Sassafras 3x on Wickliff's line thence
along said line N 69° W 13.30 chs to a large Black Oak
3x (now cut down) thence S 21° W 3.70 chs to a Red Oak
3x on said Watson's line, thence with said line S 69° E 7.70
chs to a Pine Knot 3x thence S 27° W 9 chs to a Maple 3x
on said branch thence up the meanders of said branch
to the Beginning corner, Together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances,
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
