Greenville District } J. C. Foster of the district aforesaid do hereby
give grant and convey to Nathan Davis and his Wife Elizabeth
Davis during their natural lives a certain piece or tract of
land situate in said District on the waters of Reddy River on
which the said Davis is now erecting a house. it being part
of the tract of land I now lie on and hath such bounds
as follows viz. Beginning at a Sp^{ce} Oak 34 on the Road
leading to Chicks Bridge on Saluda River. thence N 13^o W
untill it intersects my upper line next to Mrs Spencers
thence along said line to the Ridge or White horse Road
thence by said Road to the Cross made by the first mentio-
ned Road. thence by it to the Beginning which piece of
land the said Davis & Wife is to enjoy for the above specified
time as their own property. except selling conveying or
renting the same or any part thereof. The said Davis
& Wife are not to sell give or otherwise dispose of any of
the appurtenances to the said land during the above
stated time. A violation of these reservations is to be
considered a release of this obligation on me
