aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred
and eleven dollars to me paid by Alfred Nightower of the
same State and district have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release
unto the said Alfred Nightower a certain tract of land
situate in said District on the North fork of Saluda River
containing One hundred and fifty acres more or less
it being part of a tract of land formerly belonging to Thomas
Blythe Decrd and purchased by me at the sale made by an
Order of the Court of Equity of said district. The part
now to be conveyed has such bounds marks &c as follows
Viz Beginning at a Stake 3x on the East Bank of said River
thence N 83 E 38 chs to a Post Oak 3x thence S 88 E 12.50 chs
to a Pine Stump 3x thence S 89 E 6 chs to a Spanish Oak
3x thence S 13 E 6 chs to a Sassafras 3x thence S 20 W 14.50 chs
to a White Oak 3x thence N 79 W 5.25 chs to a Chestnut 3x
